Planning Board Report

Planning Board meeting was held on Thursday, August 4, 2022 with 3 members present, secretary and 2 residents present.

- Kathleen Koblensky and her husband presented survey map for minor subdivision at 90 County Rt. 59, tax map #280.-2-35, 21 acres. They will be creating 2 new lots, one with 2.57 acres and 2.65 acres. Leaving a remaining of approximately 16 acres with the house. Planning Board granted permission to move forward with the Public Hearing for the September 1st meeting.
- The next Planning Board meeting will be Thursday, September 1, 2022.

Town Clerk Report

- The sale of 2022 -23 hunting licenses started on Monday, August 1st. The sale of DMP's will be till October 1st.
- Town Clerk's office will be closed August 22nd – 29th.

Highway Report
