Earl Horton will be purchasing the remaining farm land which is being put in the farmland trust with ASA. The Planning Board granted permission to proceed with survey.

Copses Farm LLC. (Former owner was Pat Hepp) Tax Map #288.-1-23, 97 County Rt. 74, 100.30. Proposing to subdivide out 5 acres with the house. Brian Holbritter is the surveyor and Jacob Keasbey, his assistant presented the minor subdivision. The 5 acres and the house will remain with the Hepp family and Copses Farms, LLC will farm the remaining acreage. Planning Board granted permission to proceed with survey.
